**INTRODUCTION:**

The state of Odisha is in the eye of the storm and is a talking point at the national level for its acute and poverty conditions. Since independence, things are little changed, especially for the poor and the down-trodden. Even though several schemes and programmes are implemented for the welfare of the poor and marginalized. But somehow due to systemic failure the fruits have not reached to the targeted beneficiaries. Due to the huge size of the country and problems of inaccessibility and to a large extent due to lack of awareness marginalized sections of the society do not demand their due rights. Realizing the need to make the people aware a group of young people with similar thought process came together in the backward areas of Ganjam district, which is one of the most backward regions in the state. This group of like minded workers tried their best to ensure the right entitlements to the people and tried to take the fruits of technology to the people. Later, this small forum was registered as a voluntary organisation under relevant acts to enable it to receive funds from various quarters.

## **ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN DURING THE YEAR 2017-18**

During the reporting period the organization undertook several programmes for reaching the objective of the organization. While implementing the projects care was taken to put more emphasis on the process of empowerment so that they can take the development agenda further. During the reporting period the organization has undertaken the several programmes for the target group. A brief profile of activities undertaken during the period is provided below.

### **HEALTH PROGRAMMES**

#### **Arogya + (Mobile Health Unit)**

Our organization CARD implementing the Arogya + (MHU) under PPP mode in inaccessible area in 5 GPs under Suroda block, CHC Badagada of Ganjam district Odisha and also implementing the Arogya + (MHU) under PPP mode in inaccessible area in 4 GPs under Mohana block, CHC Mohana of Gajapati district Odisha.

Primarily addresses the needs of multiple health services like provision of RCH services, School Health Services, Family Planning Services along with the curative services as provisioned. IEC and social mobilization campaign on the issues of health, sanitation and nutrition are integrated under the initiative through the Arogya+ (MHU). The whole effort is on Public Private Partnership (PPP) Model under NHM.

#### **Steering committee meeting of Arogya+**



CARD was organized local steering committee meeting of Arogya+ at CHC Suroda & CHC Mohana conference hall under chairmanship of MO I/C CHC Badagada & Mohana. Attend the all Sarpanch, ANMs, CRCC, BPM & President of 4 GKS in project area attended the programme. Formation of local steering committee for implementation of Arogya plus MHU programme PPP mode in 5 GPs of Suroda block of Ganjam District & 4 GPs of Mohana block of Gajapati district

The steering committee to guide and monitor various activities being undertaken under project area as per monthly micro plan. one Sarpanch on rotation basis will act as chairman of the local steering committee on quarterly basis. Annual schedule for the same will be approved by ZSS Ganjam and communicated to partner NGO.



## Curative



The mobile health units were organized health check up camp in different villages of project area. According to the monthly action plan they arrange 44 points in different village and we have also conducted the school level health camp & check up school students check up the health and distributed medicines to the patients. They also referred serious patients to nearby PHC/CHC.

## RCH Service & awareness



CARD created awareness and provided RCH services like registration within 3 month of pregnancy, 3 ANC check up, Minor surgical, Promotion of I.D. Referral of complicated pregnancy, Promotion of immunization, treatment of childhood illness, Adolescent care such as life skill education, counseling and minor treatment

## Eligible couple sensitization meeting



CARD MHU conducted E.C. sensitization meeting, Eligible couples were participated and sensitized on RTI/STI, safe sex, F.P method use of OCP, condom and benefit of JSY schemes. Doctor and ANM attended in the sensitization meeting and distributed condom & oral pills to EC and sensitize them on birth gap method.

### Disease control programme

MHU staffs were identified the malaria cases in the camp through RDK test, giving them primary treatment and referred to them nearby CHC for treatments. The team also identified TB cases, refer them to CHC & also follow up them. The leprosy cases are also referring to nearby CHC.

### Strengthening of GKS

CARD conducted the GKS sensitization programme through MHU. They sensitize to conduct regular meeting of GKS for proper utilization of GKS untied fund. Aim & objective of GKS, Preparation of village health & water sanitation plan and water sanitation, maintenance of swasthya kantha. Role & responsibility of president of GKS, AWW cum convener and ASHA of GKS for smooth implementation of the GKS programme. People are aware on GKS & get the health information, hygiene of water & sanitation & cleanness of village & proper maintenance of swasthya kantha.



### Strengthening of VHND



The MHU staff facilitate to VHND. The main objective of this programme to ensure ANC check-up, immunization, counselling the mothers on breast feeding, family planning, PNC care, nutrition, new born care etc. MHU staff also support for presence of ANM, AWW as well as mother & child.

### Immunization camp



The ANM attend the routine immunization camp and facilitated the immunization. They immunize the infant and children and also give the proper tablets and TT to pregnant women. MHU staffs were motivated the Mothers and support Immunization camp.

### IEC Campaign:

IEC plays a vital role dissemination of health information to the people, especially in the rural areas. Need-based like JSY, Janani Express, VHND, GKS & routine immunization etc and appropriate development/ procurement of wall writings, posters/pamphlets/ booklets etc. were developed and distributed to the target group on a regular basis.



## **Urban health programme under RCH in slum areas of Berhampur**

### **Formation of MAS & WKS**



Our organization CARD implementing the slim urban health programme in 43 slim areas under Berhampur Municipal Corporation. We have formation of 42 nos. Mahila Arogya Samiti (MAS) & 6 nos. of Ward Kalyan Samiti (WKS) before formation Mahili Arogya Samiti we have aware on aim & objective of MAS & WKS to community, ASHA, AWW, SHG leaders & School teachers under the chairmanship of local corporator. We have also sensitize how to implementation & how to work like cleanness of street/ basti. Use of drinking water & sanitation and health care & aware of pregnant women & lactating mother & their parents. And referral service to serious patients near hospital. They provide health service and treatment.

### **Sensitization of community on urban slum health programme**



Our organization CARD conducted the Sensitization of community meeting on urban health programme under RCH-II in slum area of Berhampur Municipal Corporator, ASHA, AWW, vulnerable community and other stake holders attended in this meeting. The PC and Chief functionary of CARD speak about urban health under RCH programme and aware JSY, immunization, Nutrition, Birth Registration, Family Planning method, safe water & sanitation, prevention of malaria, chicken guinea etc.

### **Sensitization meeting on RCH for SHGs/ Balika Mandal**



CARD conducted SHGs/ Balika Mandal meeting at Berhampur urban slum area. Especially for SHGs& Mother's education sessions were conducted on RCH aspects. The discussion topics were RCH, Immunization, ANC/PNC, HIV/AIDS, JSY, Contraceptive vise, Childcare, Adolescent care, Nutrition, Birth Registration, Family Planning method.

## Immunization



CARD Facilitated immunization session and immunized to infant. According the strategy for child survival, with the cooperation of health worker. AWW, ASHA in immunization programme scheduled on their different places of the urban slum project area covering dropout Children.

## RTI/STI screening & treatment camp



Link volunteers of CARD organization survey in the slum area and identified adolescents, suspected RTI/STI cases. In HND CARD organization organized counseling meeting for adolescent girls and identified suspected cases by ANM. One RTI/STI camp organized by CARD Training Centre. Dr. Sailabala Panda attended the camp. At first she counseled the adolescent girls and pregnant women's on symptoms of RTI/STI, maintain hygienic in menstrual period. 85 nos. of adolescents and pregnant mother attended the health camp. Dr. Sailabala Panda also treated the RTI/STI cases, Distributed free medicine and refer critical cases to DHH. Both ANM also counseled the adolescent on early marriage contraceptive maintain hygienic and on prevention and control of AIDS.

## **MANAGEMENT OF PHC (NEW) AT P.GOVINDAPUR**



The PHC (New) at Govindapur of Gajapati district managed by CARD organization since 5 years. It covered 4 nos. sub-centers 76 nos. villages 12839 population and 38 GKS. The quality health service provided to the people through PHC (N). We have also provided the outreach health services to the community as per monthly action plan and provide free medicine to patients

The sector level meeting conducted on 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday in every month at PHC (N) P.Govindapur. ASHA, AWW, H.W.(F & M), Supervisor, HI, PC and MO I/C of PHC (New) attended the meeting and discussed on the activities like immunization, birth, death report, Malaria, TB, and other diseases control programme and status of VHND like registration of PW, ANC & PNC, institutional delivery status and motivation to adolescent, pregnant women and lactating mother. Dr. Sibaram Panda MO I/C of PHC (New) review the sector level meeting and suggested to ASHA, AWW & ANM regular attend in the VHND and immunization session.

### Malaria control & prevention programme

CARD implemented malaria control and prevention programme in 50 villages under Merapalli, Luhagudi & Sikulipadar GP of Mohana block of Gajapati district. Supported by Sir Doraji Tata Trust & Alliance, Mumbai. The following activities are

Every month MRPs were organized 2 nos. awareness meeting in each village. They explain about the aim & objectives of the programme. MRPs also collected data from the village through VHW from community. They aware on prevention, control & treatment of malaria. Orientation training of VHW





CARD organized Orientation training at training center Chandiput for 50 nos. VHWs. They oriented on Sign & symptoms of malaria, Treatment of malaria, How to prevent Life cycle of mosquito Use of mosquito net & impregnation of mosquito net Reduction of breeding site Govt. schemes for prevention of malaria. We have also distribution to beneficiaries mosquito net as per need of size family and neem oil for protection of malaria

### Mal mal camp



CARD conducted mal mal camp in every village of 3 GP 5 under mohana block of Gajapati District. The MRPs were test the blood of children under the age group of (0 to 5). Pregnant women and other fever cases through RDK. Our staffs also provide free medicines to the patients and refer them to near PHC/CHC.

### School awareness programme



CARD also conducted school level camps & aware on malaria prevention & control to school children in 15 nos. schools. Create awareness on malaria prevention & control, reduce breeding site, use of mosquito net and neem oil & cleanness the surrounding of house

### **Orientation training to ASHA & GKS members on malaria**



CARD conducted training for ASHA & GKS members on prevention and control of malaria. They trained on Sign & symptoms of malaria, treatment of malaria, how to prevent it Life cycle of mosquito, use of mosquito net & impregnation of mosquito net, reduction of breeding site Govt. schemes for prevention of malaria Health plan & role & responsible of ASHA & GKS member on prevention & treatment of malaria.

### **Cultural programme**



CARD has been working for the protection of the tribal culture. To promote the tribal culture a cultural programme was performed in the Mohana Block headquarter. This tribal group is also used to spread awareness & consciousness among rural people on HIV/AIDS, T.B. eradication, Malaria

### **Workshop on sensitization of family planning NSV/ CV camps**



Our organization CARD conducted the block level sensitization workshop on family planning programme for NSV/ CV camps at Block conference hall Mohana block of Gajapati district. The block chairman, BDO, CDPO, BEE, BPM, Sarpanch, PRI member, AWW, ICDS Supervisor, President of GKS, ASHA, NGO & CBO were attended the workshop. The guest of honour Mr. Akul Nayak Block Development Officer, Mohana speak about as per census 2011 the population is growth of Mohana block around 1 lakh 50 thousand. In family planning for tubectomy 15-20 days rest is need for a mother, but vasectomy a male person only need half an hour. He advise to PRI representative and other participants to motivate the community for male sterilization. The above workshop helped to create awareness on the issue of NSV without any operation. Some participants take responsibility about mobilization of community for NSV. Some Sarpanch also gave feedback that conduct GP level workshop.



### Programme on HIV/AIDS



Our organization conducted the HIV/AIDS awareness programme on world AIDS Day. At present state of knowledge there is no curative therapy of this dreaded infection. The only way is to prevent the infection. Only way out to keep this dreaded infection is prevention which can be done with some simple adherence. Besides, there are a lot of misinformation and prejudice against HIV/AIDS. CARD tried to address all these issues by organizing

awareness programme on World AIDS Day. Supported by Odisha State AIDS Control Society & Zilla Swasthy Samity, Ganjam a Public Meeting was organized by a mass rally in Rangeilunda block. More than 150 nos. ASHA & AWWs participated in this rally displaying placards, posters, banners with the message preventing HIV/AIDS. In the public meeting conducted after the rally, the resource persons emphasized on controlling the infection on a war footing and called upon all the stakeholders to do everything for its entry into the general population. Programmes like training, workshops were conducted also in Kukudakhandi and Rangeilunda blocks.

### Management of Urban (PHC) for slum area of Berhampur



CARD managing urban PHC programme under PPP mode at Baikuntha Nagar Berhampur for slum peoples. The main aim of the UPHC is to provide primary health services to slum people. The main activities of programme are



- Provide primary health service to slum people
- Emergency services during epidemic/ outbreak of communicable disease
- Blood, haemoglobin, urine, pregnancy, sugar & malaria testing, HIV testing etc.
- ANC & PNC check up
- Counselling to patients, pregnant woman, lactating mother and adolescents.
- Free medicine distribution
- ICUD family planning programme
- Pradhan Mantri Surkhya Matrutwa Yojana (PMSMY) for check up of pregnant mother
- Outreach health camp
- Visit & monitoring to UHND & immunization point by medical officer



### Urban mobile health unit (MHU) in slum areas of Berhampur



Our organization CARD implementing the urban mobile health unit (MHU) under PPP mode in slum areas of Berhampur of Ganjam district Odisha

Primarily addresses the needs of multiple health services like provision of RCH services, Family Planning Services along with the curative services as provisioned. IEC and social mobilization campaign on the issues of health, sanitation and nutrition are integrated under the initiative through the MHU. The whole effort is on Public Private Partnership (PPP) Model under NUHM.

#### **Health checkup camp**



The mobile health units were organized health check up camp in different slum areas BMC. According to the monthly action plan they arrange 44 points in different wards health check up and distributed medicines to the patients. They also referred serious patients to nearby City hospital & MKCG Berhampur.



### RCH Service & awareness



CARD created awareness and provided RCH services like registration with 3 month of pregnancy, 3 ANC check up, Minor surgical, Promotion of I.D. Referral of completed pregnancy, Promotion of immunization, treatment of childhood illness, Adolescent care such as life style education, counseling and minor treatment

### Eligible couple sensitization meeting



CARD MHU conducted E.C. sensitization meeting & eligible couples were participated and sensitized on RTI/STI, safe sex, F.P method use of OCP, condom and benefit of JSY schemes. Doctor and ANM attended in the sensitization meeting and distributed condom & oral pills. Eligible couples were sensitized on birth gap method.

### Disease control programme

MHU staffs were identified the malaria cases test through RDK and treated positive cases and identified TB cases refer them to PHC & also follow up them. The leprosy cases are also referring to nearby PHC.

### Strengthening of UHND



The MHU staff facilitate to UHND. The main objective of this programme to ensure ANC check-up, immunization, counselling the mothers on breast feeding, family planning, PNC care, nutrition, new born care etc. MHU staff also support for presence of ANM, AWW as well as mother & child.

### **Immunization camp**

The ANM attend the routine immunization camp and facilitated the immunization. They immunize the infant and children and also give the prepare tablets and TT to pregnant women. MHU staffs were motivated the Mothers to support Immunization camp.



### **IEC Campaign:**



IEC plays a vital role dissemination of health information to the people, especially in the slum areas. Need-based like JSY, UHND & routine immunization, water & sanitation, prevent to majors of malaria, dengue etc. pamphlets/ booklets etc. were developed and distributed to the target group on a regular basis.

### **Campaign against sex determination test**

Over the past few years there has been an increase in the sex-based termination of pregnancy. This has resulted in a worrying sex ratio against the females. Under the Indian laws sex-determination tests are illegal and there is PC PNDT Act against those persons directly or indirectly encouraging these practices. As an organisation working on the field of Mother and Child Health, the organisation has been working on making all stakeholders aware regarding this act and to discourage parents as well as testing laboratory conducting these tests. Supported by Director, Health & FW Deptt, Govt. of Odisha the organisation is monitoring all the ultrasound clinics where such tests are conducted. **CARD** also organised a workshop to make the operators of such clinic where they were made aware of the PNDT Act in which there is strict punitive actions against violation of the act.

### **Addressing adolescent pregnancy programme in 6 blocks of Ganjam district.**



CARD conducted district level sensitization workshop on addressing the adolescent pregnancy programme in Ganjam district. Medical Officer, CDPO, ABDO & SEO attended the workshop. CDMO, ADMO (FW) & DPM attend as a guest of honour in the workshop. Dr. S. Behuria and Rudra Prasad Pradhan attended as a resource person.



Block level sensitization programme on adolescent programme conducted at Kukudakhadi, Rangeilunda, Digapahandi, Chikiti, Sanakhemundi and Patrapur invited ICDS Supervisor, AWW, PRI members, SHG leader & ANM to the workshop. BDO, MO I/C, CDPO & DPO UNFPA attended as a guest cum resource person. Mr. Suresh Chandra Sahu President cum Director of CARD presented the block level status of early marriage of adolescents with in age of 15 to 18 years for more than 40% adolescents are married before 18 years. So discuss about protection of early marriage and those are already married adopt gap method through contraceptives and counseling the newly married eligible couples on use of contraceptives for delay pregnancy.

### National TB control programme



Tuberculosis has been a major threat to the health of people since long. It is also a fatal disease killing many people a year in the region infecting over one third of the population. Realizing the fact, **CARD** has been trying to contribute its bit in Govt.'s effort to control this highly contagious disease. Supported the District Health Administration and Lepara Society, the programme is being implemented in eight G.P.s of Kukudakhadi Block of Ganjam district. Under the programme various activities were undertaken.

### Malaria control programme



The entire Ganjam district is a malaria-endemic area. The district reports one of the highest cases of malarial fever. Though people suffer from this disease year after year there seems to be very little awareness to prevent it. Many a times the disease becomes fatal. **CARD** is trying to convince the peoples of Kukudakhadi block that through a little care the disease can be controlled to a great extent. The people are urged to keep their surroundings clean and they are advised to use a mosquito net. The people were also advised to use local methods like treating the house with smokes from *jhuna*, dry cow dung and dry *neem* leaves which are quite effective in driving the mosquito.

Supported by Ministry of Health and family Welfare, Govt. of India and the District Health Administration a programme was undertaken to provide medicated mosquito nets to the people under the **Bed Net Impregnation Programme** through the District Vector-Borne Disease Control Society, Ganjam. Under the programme impregnated mosquito nets were



provided to 524 BPL and 754 APL households. The programme was undertaken in eight malaria-endemic G.P.s of Kukudakhundi Block in Ganjam district. This small step has resulted in drastic reduction of malarial fever in these areas. The organization plans to cover more areas under the project.

#### **District level workshop on gram swasthya samikhya (GSS)**

Our organization CARD organizing the Environment Awareness programme in rural areas of Kukudakhundi Block. The programme created the environment awareness among the people through workshop, village meeting, Padayatra, by volunteers, door to door motivation, competition among school students, leaflets, were distributed, nursery rising and distributed seedling of trees for plantation programme among the villagers.

### **Observance of Various Community Events**

Community participation is one of the most important pre-condition for providing efficient health services to the people. But most of the time people are not involved in health administration. So in order to inform the people on the importance of good health and facilities provided by the Govt. various community events were conducted as part of the programme. The following community events were organised during the reporting period.

#### **World Health Day**

World Health Day was observed at Berhampur to highlight the importance of maintaining good health. A rally was organised By CARD with participation by AWW, ASHA, SHG member and Volunteer of the organization. The objective of the programme was to attract the attention of general public to make them aware of their duty to keep good health.





### World Population Day



India is facing the problem of population explosion which needs urgent attention. As an organisation working in the field of women and child health, **CARD** has been making people aware regarding their reproductive rights. In order to highlight the importance of family planning, the organisation observed the World Population Day CARD Organised a rally with the collaboration of ZSS from municipality office to CDMO office. A meeting was arranged in the IEC hall of CDMO.

### World Breast Feeding Week



Mother's milk is the best nutrition for the child, especially the new born. In order to make the people understand the people, and especially the importance of exclusive breast feeding, World Breast Feeding Week was observed. During this week the workers and volunteers of the organization made sure that all the newborns have the privilege of being breast-fed by the mothers. On the occasion the volunteers and workers of the organization made home visits and encouraged the lactating mothers to undertake exclusive breast-feeding for at least six months. Various programmes like rallies, public meetings, poster shows were organized to highlight the importance of the occasion.

### Safe Motherhood Day



Our organization CARD Observed international women's day at Berhampur Municipality slum area. Our organization organized a sensitization meeting on violation of women rights and protect of the girl child at slum area, Berhampur. CDMO Ganjam attended as a Chief guest and ADMO (FW), Dy. MEIO Berhampur attended as a guest of honor. The Chief Guest speaks about key message on protect the women and girl child from trafficking and violation. Dr. Sabita Mishra ADMO (FW) also speaks on breast feeding to their child and raises their voice against violation.

### Gender disparity in girl child education programme (DAP) in 12 villages under Rangeilunda block of Ganjam district



CARD Organization identified the 400 nos. of village girls are belongs from labour class family they are not able to buy their education material like school bag, geometric box, note book, dictionary etc. so our organization decided to select the girl child in some criteria like she belongs from SC/ST family/ BPL family, she has the interest on continuing the study. CARD conducted sensitization meeting in 12 nos. schools Involving students of 12 nos. village and sensitized the adolescent girls on health & hygienic, value of education, need of education and encourage them to continue their study. According to their need support them school bag, geometric box & text book.. District Inspector of schools attend the programme and thanks to CARD organization for support of reading material, tuition fees for dropout & poor girls going to regular school and sensitize the parents and VEC members.

### Women Empowerment Programme

Process of women empowerment, the organisation has formed and strengthened women self-help groups in the operational area of the district. The organisation is trying to link some of these groups to formal financial institutions like banks for credit off take. As of the end of the financial year 2014-2015, CARD has promoted more than 30 groups who after proper training and capacity-building are working at various level of efficiency. The parents of disability is also formed self help group and starting income generating programme to support their children. CARD provide vocational training like coir product & mushroom cultivation which they are selling in local market.

### Programme on Women Atrocities

Women in the rural areas are one of the most disadvantaged groups. Due to high level of ignorance and high level of illiteracy they are exploited by the society and the family members. Gender-based violence and domestic violence perpetrated against the women is common. Due to ignorance of law and lack of bias the victims most often do not resort to legal protection. In order to address the issue CARD organized a district level seminar to make the women aware of the legal and constitutional protection available to address such atrocities. District officials, police and judicial officials explained the women who are victims of domestic, gender and caste-based atrocities how to take recourse to legal options in case of such violations. Similarly, two Block level workshops were organised in Digapahandi & Rangeilunda Block headquarters to educate the women regarding the legal remedies available in case of violation of their rights. More than 260 women, mostly belonging to the marginalised section attended the programme. In this occasion we have invited Mr. Gopal Chandra Satapathy Advocate attend as a chief guest and speak about legal rights of women and Dr. Subhadra Mangu as a guest of honour and speak about health problem of women and self protection.

## Programme on livelihood



The operational area of the organisation is primarily in a very backward area where there is prevalent of rampant poverty. In the district of Ganjam and Gajapati people depend entirely on agriculture and associated activities for their living. The entire agricultural operation is rain-fed. So during scanty or erratic rainfall, the people have to stare at the prospect of draught. In order to address this problem, CARD is working to provide the people will alternative livelihood sources by using modern methods. During the programme the following programmes were undertaken to enhance and supplement the income sources.

## Integrated Development of the Marginalized Community



Mohana Block of Gajapati district is known for its rampant poverty and impoverishment. The marginalised people, especially the *dalits* & *adivasis* struggle to arrange two square meals a day for self and family. As the land is infertile and most of them are upland, income from the agricultural fields is not able to sustain the family income round the year. So they have to venture outside the district in search of work. In order to address this problem, **CARD** implemented a programme to enhance the livelihood through the process of empowerment in two GPs of Merapalli and Sikulipadar under Mohana block of Gajapati district. Activities like formation and strengthening of SHG, capacity-building and managerial leadership training were provided to the groups to make the groups self-sustainable. As alternative livelihood programme, the organisation provided training in vocational trades of Buffet plate making, stitching of leaf plates. The organisation provided the initial support like machineries, raw materials etc. to start their micro-enterprises. The organisation also provided the initial support to market the entire products. Now the groups have become self-sufficient.



**DCW programme**

Our organization CARD implementing: Inclusive development of deaf children through community empowerment and strengthening of parents programme in kukudakhundi and rangeilunda block. The CBR team working for 74 DC and 124 DYP. Our organization conducted following activities is.

**Clinical Assessment**

CARD organized clinical assessment camp at CARD training centre for 99 hearing impaired children. Mr. Bauribandhu Nayak audiologist was testing the ear through audiometer. 66 nos. children test their ear in two batches. Through the test, we know the degree of disability, it increases or not and for some children, if the treatment is need, it refers near hospital for treatment.

**DYP club meeting.**

CARD staff formed 5 nos. DYPs in 5 clusters. The main aim of the DYP club is to identify the issues of hearing impaired child & advocacy to get their rights. They also collect proper information on the availability of required resource. They are collecting information to solve these issues. They also identified the skill of DYP and planed for income generating programme.

**Community sensitization meeting**

CARD arranged GP wise sensitization meeting in 12 GPs of Kukudakhundi block & 21 GPs of Rangeilunda block. In this meeting sensitized the community & parents of deaf child on DCW project activity. The causes & prevention of disability, provision of govt. facility, inclusive education, rights of law & information about the work of DDRC etc. After the meeting CARD staff getting support from community, so it is easy to implement the programme in project area.

**Parents sensitization meeting**

CARD formed 8 nos parents association to support the DC and DYP. Every month parents conducting meeting to discuss the issues of their children, parents also planning for advocacy.. CBR staff are sensitizing to parents on disability right, law, how they will come to mainstreaming of society, how they support the childrens to became self dependence need of education for deaf child etc.. CBR team also sensitized the parents the cause of disability and how the prevent it. So they welcome this programme & request to continue it.

**Deaf awareness with ICDS workers**

CARD organization conducted deaf awareness meeting with ICDS & health workers. Here they discussed on following topics...

- Caused & prevention of disability.
- Complete ANC check up.
- Ensure all the mothers attend in VHND.
- Support them in pre-school education through special educator of CARD.
- Information of DDRC.
- Use of hearing aid from pre-school level.
- Preparation of TLM with the support of parents

The ICDS workers assured to support the programme and joining the deaf child in pre-school and give special attention to deaf child. Health worker also assured to counseling the mothers in VHND on causes and prevention of disability.

**ISL training to DC parents & deaf youths**

CARD conducted training programme for the parents of Deaf children which is based on Indian sign language, how to educate their children, how to fight the rights of their deaf children. The parents are formed SHG group in village and panchayat level. They also formed Ganjam Pratidwani to advocacy and fight for the rights of their children. The parents and deaf children exposure to DDRC, TCTD, VRC and collected information from the institution.



### **Summer camp and winter camp**

The main objectives of the programme are

- Living together & share/ conversation with each other
- To learn new skills
- To identify the skill of DC
- To develop social skill & communication
- To develop sense of independence
- To improve their self confidence
- To encourage the DC



### **Agricultural Programme under RKVY scheme**



CARD conducted the sensitization programme for farmers of Bomokey, Patrapur Turubudi, Badapur & Gundura GPs of Patrapur block, Lalmenta, K.Nuagoan, Ramchandrapur, under Chikiti Block regarding Rastriya Krushi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) Green revolution programme. AAO Patrapur & Chikiti block and DAO attended and sensitized the farmers' benefit of RKVY scheme. Provided Agricultural Deptt. Govt. of Odisha provided through NGO CARD an provision of BGREI-II scheme, deep ploughing and line planting system, application of fertilizer, soil testing, demo static rice according to agro logical condition and use of micro nutrient, 702 nos. of farmers were demonstration the rice in 500 hectares of shallow & rain fed land and highly harvested from it. Also supplied Free seeds per acre 24 kg, line planting per hector Rs.1500/-, land ploughing per hector Rs. 1250/-Zink 10 kg per acre, weed management, Free. Pesticide medicine for farmers. The programme support by PD ATMA & DDA Berhampur,

## **BIO- DIVERSITY PROGRAMME**



**CARD** formed the bio-diversity management committee in 20 GPs under Kukudakhadi block of Ganjam district with support of Odisha Bio-Diversity Board, Bhubaneswar. Before formation of committee sensitize for aim & objective of Odisha Bio-diversity Board and regular conduct the meeting secretary (local forester) with consent of president and invited all the committee members. This year CARD also sensitised the committee members on the theme of Biodiversity conservation: Present Day for Action. The programme was conducted the workshop. During this workshop detailed discussions were held on Household Solid Waste Management. Various activities like poster campaign competitions, demonstration of solid waste management were organized. The resource persons who attended the workshop how the people can protect their own environment through small steps like avoiding use of polythene bags, decomposing the solid waste generated from the households etc. The guests who attended the seminar included meetings Dr. B.K. Panda, P.K. Udgata academicians and NGO activists are attended the meeting. This year card also formed 550 nos. of BMC in 20 nos. block of Ganjam District and prepared 2 nos. peoples bio-diversity register in Sihala and Dakhinapur GPs in kukudakhadi block.

## **Block level workshop on Water and Sanitation Programme**



Our organization CARD, Berhampur conducted 2 nos. preparatory meeting/block level workshop for NRDWAW (National Rural Drinking Water Awareness) at Kukudakhadi & Sheragada block. Total 60 nos. participants i.e. concerned BDO, ABDO, CDPO, BPO, BEO, J.E, RWSS, BC, CC, Sarpanch, ASHA, AWW & NGO CARD participated in the meeting. Concerned block development officer attended in the workshop and in the above cited workshop topic were discussed on must conduct block level competition for 150 school students on drawing, debate & slogan of water & sanitation scheme and must organize the movement of Jal & Parimal Ratha (1week) by the CARD NGO with the help of concerned 2 nos. SEMs in each block for create awareness campaigning in all GPs of Sheragada, Hinjilicut and Kukudakhadi block. BDOs were decided & finalized the village/GP discussed among with the Sarpanch & SANJOG Deptt. for door to door visit for house hold survey by AWWs and selected the places to create awareness by street play/theater display. The preparation coordination meeting was closed with the vote of thanks by project coordinator CARD-NGO.



### Block level competition for school students on water & sanitation.



Our organization CARD organized the block level competition for 150 nos. high school students for drawing, debate and slogan competition at Kukudakhandi block conference hall. BDO & ABDO Kukudakhandi attended as a guest of honour and block education officer and school teachers attended as juries for above cited competition. 50 nos. ### Therapeutic & Rehabilitative Services for Persons with Intellectual Disabilities

This programme was implemented by CARD with the support of social security office for intellectual disability. The main activities of the programme are as follow. 35 nos. of MR and CP child from different grassroots level were came to therapy centre and the CARD team giving them therapeutic service

- Aware the parents on disabilities rights and facilities
- Parents are giving the therapy in their home..
- 2 nos. parents are agreed to give quality aids and appliances to their children after counseling by the therapy.
- Children are developed in strength and mobility, changes in posture etc.
- Flexibility the body part of the children which were tightness.
- Confidence of parents developed. So the0 parents regular attend the therapy center.
- Giving functional literacy to the children and improved in hand function.

- Capacity building need for project personnel for effective management and phasing out the project activities
- Follow up the plan by the CBR worker on rehabilitation of individual PWDs.
- Increasing the responsibility of the parents and care givers to play a major role in the rehabilitation/ inclusion process.
- Capacities building need for individual person / child with disabilities through regular home based rehabilitation/ integration interventions.
- Create awareness among the parents to enroll in regular schools for promoting inclusion in education.
- Strengthening of parents group to support their child.
- Promote effective community and parent's participation in the sharing of information with coordination of line departments.
- Improve the monitoring and evaluate process for its efficiency and effectiveness

### **PROTECTION OF CHILD LABOUR:**

Our organization CARD is working as survey and protection of child labour under Mohana Block of Gajapati district & slum areas of Berhampur of Ganjam district in the state of Odisha. Our organization is organizing the programme of fundamental rights of the children, the right to free primary education and the need to prohibit employment O.C. children those are reflected in the constitution of India. The Directive Principles of the constitution bears the commitment of our nation. The welfare of the children are given opportunities and facilities to develop in health manner and in conditions of freedom and dignity of childhood and projected against exploitation of child our organization also extended and formation child right Group in school level.
